<p><b>To improve the quality of the local environment and open spaces of Canford Heath</b></p>	<p><b>ARCH has already received £15,000 of CIL bid funding for Adastral Square Improvements</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ <b>This funding is specific for 4 projects</b> All the projects are to improve the appearance of Adastral Square and include a raised bed with plants, library bench and repainting of the hopscotch and maze. This project is about giving residents a sense of pride in the communal space and to reduce the intention of those that would otherwise participate in anti-social behaviour.</li> </ul> <p><b>ARCH has been awarded £1000 of CIL bid funding to repaint to Verity Park</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ <b>Repainting of play equipment at Verity Park.</b> Organise a Volunteer day bringing together various sectors of the community to help</li> </ul> <p><b>ARCH has been awarded CIL bid funding for the purchase and maintenance of 2 defibrillators</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Continue to maintain the 2 existing defibrillators installed by ARCH. A 5<sup>th</sup> sub-committee will be set up to oversee the Community Fridge project.</li> <li>❖ <b>ARCH</b> Partners may include but are not limited to; Schools, Churches, Library, Community Centre, Neighbourhood Watch, Youth workers, BCP Community Development team, BCP Council workers, BCP Ward Councillors, Local shops/traders, Care Homes, Social activities/group leaders etc</li> <li>❖ <b>ARCH</b> has created the Canford Heath Network which is for the purpose of promoting the community groups</li> </ul>
